

# Summer Fun Watermelon Card

## Stampin' Up! Supplies:

- STAMPS – Playing In The Rain (160542)
- PAPER – Lemon Lime Twist 8-1/2" x 11" Cardstock (144245), Garden Green 8-1/2" x 11" Cardstock (102584), Basic White 8-1/2" x 11" Cardstock (159276), Sweet Sorbet 8-1/2" x 11" Cardstock (159268)
- INK – Memento Ink Tuxedo Black (132708), Lemon Lime Twist Classic Stampin Pad (147145), Sweet Sorbet Classic Stampin' Pad (159216), Garden Green Classic Stampin' Pad (147145)
- OTHER – Multi Purpose Liquid Glue (110755), Trimmer (152392), Blending Brush (153611), Multipurpose Liquid Glue (110755)

## Cutting & Scoring:

- Garden Green 8-1/2" x 11" Cardstock - Base: 5-1/2" x 8-1/2" - Score at 4-1/4"
- Lemon Lime Twist 8-1/2" x 11" Cardstock: 4-1/8" x 5-3/8"
- Basic White 8-1/2" x 11" Cardstock: 4" x 5-1/4" (x2)
- Sweet Sorbet 8-1/2" x 11" Cardstock: 3-7/8" x 5-1/8"
- Basic White 8-1/2" x 11" Cardstock: 3-3/4" x 5"

## Instructions:

- Cut and score your paper
- On the smallest Basic White piece, start adding color with the stampin blends and your Sweet Sorbet, Lemon Lime Twist and Garden Green Classic Stamp Pads.
  - Start with Sweet Sorbet as this is the largest color section.
  - Apply Lemon Lime Twist next on the opposite side of the Sweet Sorbet bringing the color just so it has a little bit of white between the two.
  - Finish the Watermelon with a little bit of Garden Green at the very bottom of the Lemon Lime.
- Stamp your sentiment in the lower right corner with Tuxedo Black.
- Add in a row of rain drops in Tuxedo Black, These are your seeds.
- Attach one of the 4" x 5-1/4" Basic White panels to your Lemon Lime Twist with Liquid Glue.
- Attach the Sweet Sorbet cardstock to the Basic White.
- Attach your watermelon piece to the Sweet Sorbet.
- Attach the entire stack onto the front Garden Green base.
- Lightly apply a little Sweet Sorbet to the corners of the remaining Basic White (I literally just cleaned my blending brush on the corners) and then stamp some rain drops on the bottom stampin off several times to keep them light.
- Attach that panel to the inside of the card base.
- Enjoy!
