Crushed Curry Classic Stampin' Pad [147087] \$9.00, Daffodil Delight Classic Stampin' Pad [147094] \$9.00, Cajun Craze Classic Stampin' Pad [147085] \$9.00

Card Stock Basic White 8 1/2" X 11" Cardstock [159276] \$10.50, Daffodil Delight 8-1/2" X 11" Cardstock [119683] \$10.00

## **Tools & Adhesive**

Multipurpose Liquid Glue [110755] \$5.50, Blending Brushes [153611] \$13.00, Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine [149653] \$128.00, Pecan Pie Classic Stampin' Pad [161665] \$9.00, Sending Dies (English) [159271] \$33.00, Loose Frosted Dots [161153] \$8.00

### Cutting & Scoring:

- Basic White 8-1/2" x 11" Cardstock : 5-1/2" x 8-1/2" scored at 4-1/4"
  Basic White 8-1/2" x 11" Cardstock : 4" x 5-1/4"
- Daffodil Delight 8-1/2" x 11" Cardstock: 4-1/8" x 5-3/8"
- Daffodil Delight 8-1/2" x 11" Cardstock: 2" x 4"

Instructions:

- Cut and Score your paper
- Tape the 4" Basic White down to keep in place. I used old washi tape.
- Lay the sunflower stencil over the card stock at a slight angle. Over in the upper left corner you will see a notch (#1), trace that so you have a guide for the rest of the masks.
- With Blending Brushes apply Daffodil Delight and Crushed Curry to the sunflower. I started from the center with Crushed Curry and worked my way out with Daffodil Delight.
- Line up the second mask (#3) with the notch over the sunflower.
- Apply Pecan Pie to the center section of the sunflower.
- Line up the notch on the final one (#4)! This is actually important so that everything lines up exactly the way it is suppose to.
- Apply Cajun Craze to give detail to the center of the sunflower.
- Set that aside and grab the smaller Daffodil Delight cardstock.
- Set the first mask over it and apply Crushed Curry to the sunflowers. Keep a light hand here and try not to go to dark. If you do, its okay as it will create a little dimension.
- · Move the mask around and fill in blank spaces with sunflowers.
- Using mask #3, you add a little Pecan Pie to the center of the flowers, or you can leave them be.
- At this point, I went ahead and did the same thing to the inside of the card as the I did for the card front.
- Stamp the word SENDING onto the stamped Daffodil Delight piece with Pecan Pie ink.
- Cut it out with the coordinating dies and your Cut and Emboss Machine.
- Attach this to the Basic White with liquid glue.
- Underneath the SENDING, stamp the word SUNSHINE, from the sentiment "sunshine to brighten your day". Use Crushed Curry ink for this.
- Stamp the rest of the sentiment on the inside of your card also with Crushed Curry.
- Attach the Basic White card front to the larger Daffodil Delight piece with liquid glue.
- Attach that to the Basic White Card Base also with liquid glue.
- Add a couple Loose Frosted Dots and your all done!
- ENJOY!
